Requests received in writing by the early registration deadline will be fully refunded. Requests received after June 1 will be refunded only in the case of extreme hardship which will be determined at the discretion of the organizing committee.

Conflicting demands of people and resource use in the Okanagan Valley has resulted in multiple management challenges. We invite you to experience, first hand, the impact of wildfire, extensive salvage harvesting, and ecosystem restoration in two community watersheds. Speakers will present several perspectives.

The ferocious Mountain Pine Beetle attack resulted in large clear-cut harvests to salvage timber stands. Large fires in '03 and '09 exposed streams and domestic water supplies to erosion. Seeding was done to control erosion and weeds and increase forage management.

Salvage logging and fire created large openings which led to significant difficulties for ranchers to manage their rangelands. Increased demand for recreation on public lands brings new challenges. Domestic water protection requirements have escalated and added to the complexity of resource planning for often conflicting values of range, recreation, timber, mining, water wildlife and real estate.

We will examine various tools and principles used in managing for rangelands, water values, and ecosystem restoration. You will hear the experiences of those involved.

Don't miss this opportunity to visit the sunny Okanagan and hear a little history around the evening watering hole on the Gold Rush Trails and the famous Kettle Valley Railroad.
